A draft PNP memo covers guidelines for accreditation of logistics providers, customs brokers, freight forwarders, and truckers, manufacturers, dealers, and purchasers with company-owned vehicles engaged in the land transportation and movement of controlled chemicals using truck lorries, tractor head loading container vans, closed vans, and similar other vehicles.

3:30-4:00 Strategic Trade Management Act (Republic Act 10697 or An Act Preventing the Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction by Managing the Trade in Strategic Goods, the Provision of Related Services, and for Other Purpose)

Under RA 10697, any person who engages or intends to engage in the export, import, and re-export of strategic goods -- products that, for security reasons or due to international agreements, are considered to be of such military importance that their export is either prohibited altogether or subject to specific conditions -- or provides related services shall register directly with the Strategic Trade Management Office prior to applying for an authorization or a governmental end-use assurance.
